

BMW CHAMPIONSHIP RESULTS OVERVIEW

The RSM Player Performance Study is collecting data on professional golfers to identify the key drivers of success. Two of the metrics we are tracking are time spent over the ball and pre-shot routine. Time spent at address is defined as when a player sets up to the ball to impact. Our data collection at the BMW Championship at Wentworth has provided some initial insights:



TIME SPENT AT ADDRESS

The best approach and tee shots at the BMW Championship were hit when players spent less time from address to impact.



PRE-SHOT ROUTINE OVERVIEW

2 practice swings and 2 looks at the target are the most common pre-shot routines.
